6. Three red balls and five green balls are in the basket. How many balls are in the basket?

7. Ellen has six more apples than Amy. Amy has nine apples. How many apples does Ellen have?

8. Adam has eight oranges and Allan has eight oranges. How many oranges do Adam and Allan have together?

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
